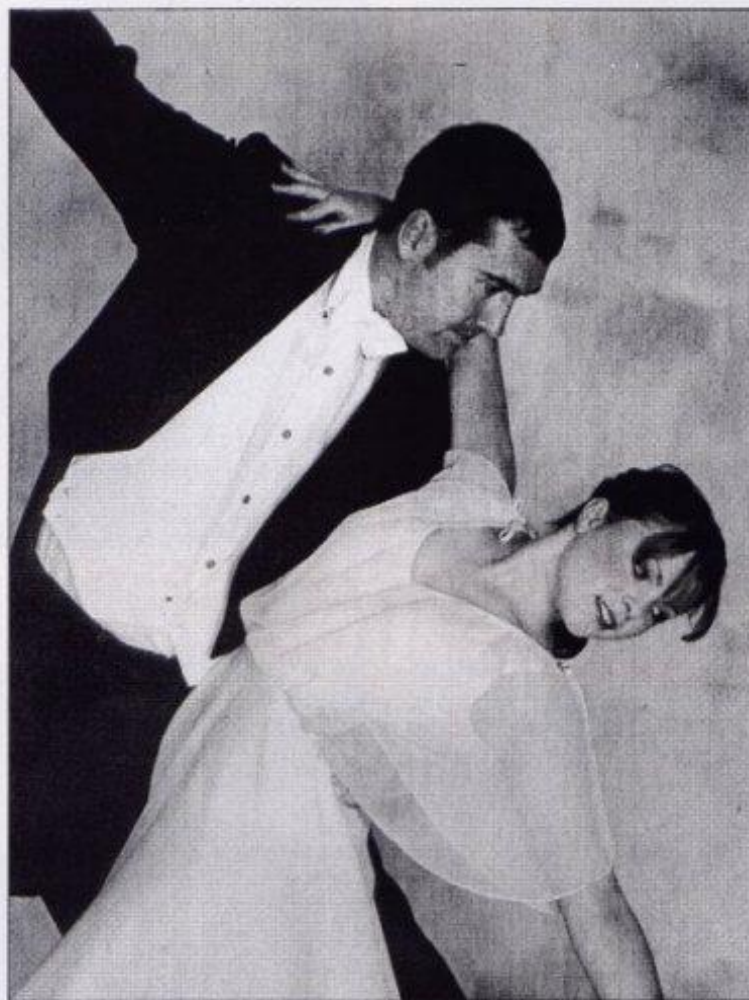
Michael and Alison along with the rest of the production team have put a great deal of time and effort into the show and the members of the cast have also worked extremely hard in rehearsals.

In 1992 at the Shubert Theatre, The American Broadway musical made an all-singing, all dancing comeback with the premiere of "Crazy For You", an adaptation of the George and Ira Gershwin 1930 hit "Girl Crazy". 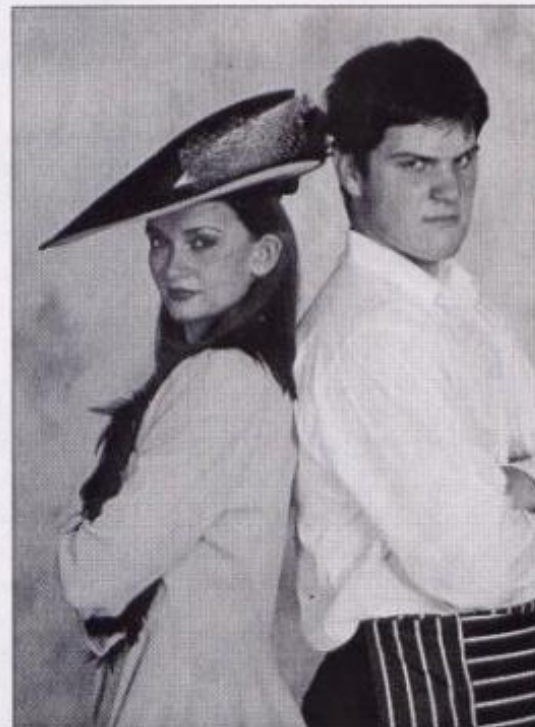

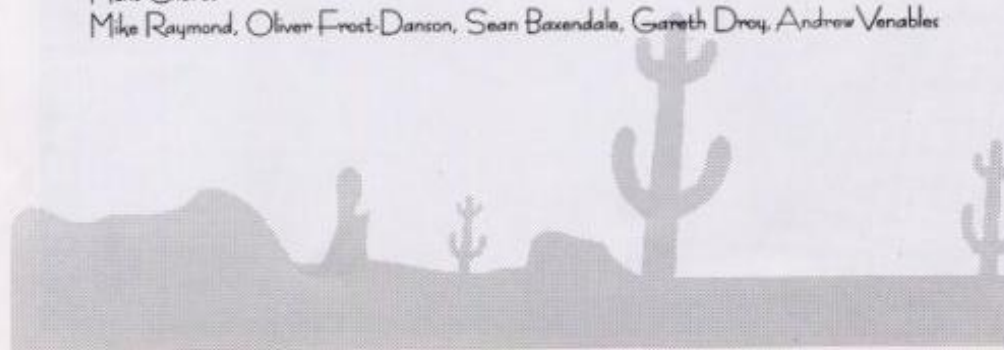

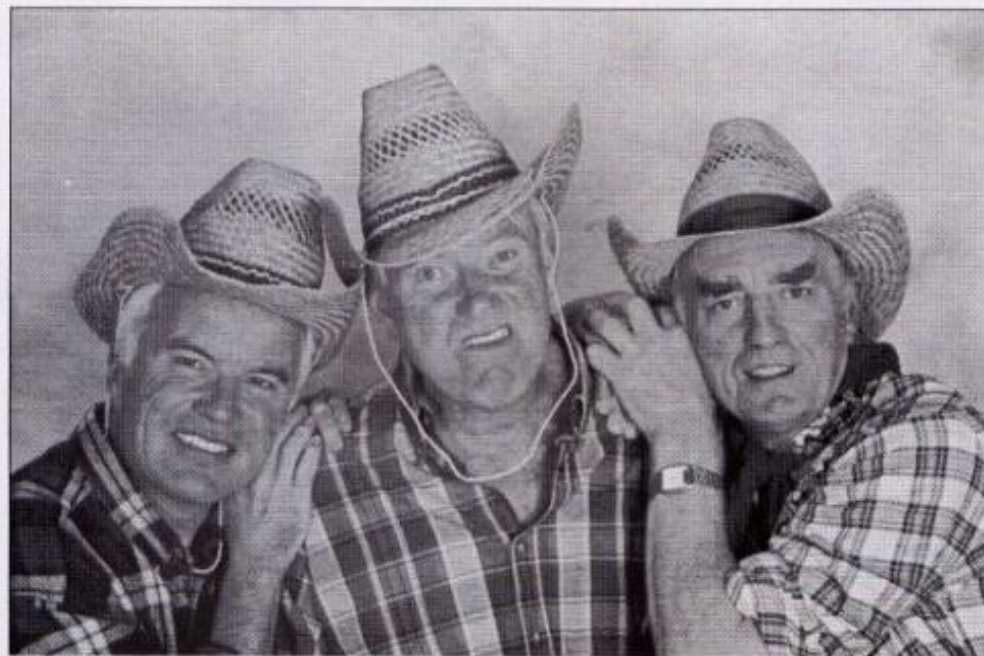
