

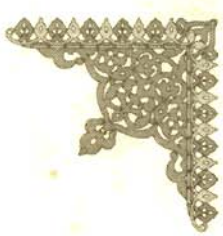



Now sit back and enjoy the show.

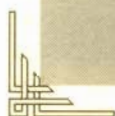
