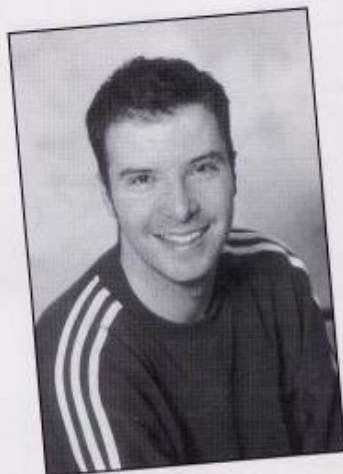

Loving Bill deeply, but not wanting to spoil his chances, Sally tries to convince Bill that he is now too good for her. She even invades his 'coming out' party with her rowdy friends, but everyone - the Duchess included - joins in the fun of the Lambeth Walk.

However, the Duchess decrees that Sally must go and the humiliated girl returns to Lambeth. But she is sought out by an unexpected sympathiser, Sir John, who knows what it is to suffer a shattered romance as he has loved the Duchess for years. He arranges for her to be coached secretly to be a lady.

Back at the Hall, the Hunt Ball is in progress and Bill is determined to leave the Hall to find Sally and give up on his new life.

A whirlwind ending ensues, with some very nice surprises for all.
